The exchange system with euro pallets (DRX ID 210) and skeleton boxes/ Gitterboxen (DRX ID 110), named Europool exchange system as well, isn't common in all countries of the EU countries. The contract is not based between the countries but the actual exchange partners have contracts which each other.

That's why the deliveries from and to international customers and suppliers have to be reviewed strictly all the time whether and in what manner the handling of the exchange will be in detail.

Deliveries to DRX Group

In the following it's explained when incoming deliveries have to be managed with a shipping agent account or with the supplier himself:

FROM	Unfree/ not prepaid shipment	Prepaid shipment
Europool – Exchange Country	Shipping Agent	Supplier
Europool – Non-Exchange Country	Supplier	Supplier

Deliveries from DRX Group

In the following it's explained when outgoing deliveries have to be managed with a shipping agent account or with the supplier himself:

TO	Unfree/ not prepaid shipment	Prepaid Shipment
Europool – Exchange Country	Supplier	Shipping Agent
Europool – Non-Exchange Country	Supplier	Supplier

General

- Only a few countries have an active part in the exchange of pallets in general cargo: Belgium, Denmark, Germany, France (only local), Italy, Luxembourg, Netherlands, Austria, Switzerland
- Defective euro pallets/ skeleton boxes have to be noted imperatively on the CMRs/ consignment notes. These won't be credited on the account by incoming deliveries.

Exceptions

- The account will be managed directly with the DRX Group if there are any deliveries with the shipping agent Reiter.
- In case of special transports which are caused and paid by supplier, the account has to be managed with the supplier and not the shipping agent.
